Whenever City Council approval is required for a new contract or for an 19 amendment to an existing contract for services or consultants, within 30 days following a City Department's determination to procure or amend such contract, the department Director or the 20 21 Director's designee shall transmit to the Council President, the Chair of the appropriate Council 22 committee, and file with the City Clerk written notification of the contracting department's 23 determination to procure or amend such contract. The written notification shall contain the 24 following information:

A. A short narrative summarizing the department's proposed new or amended scope of work, the duration of the contract or amendment, and the terms of the contract or amendment; and
