



Resolution 31768 ADOPTED

A RESOLUTION relating to funding for construction and long-term operations and management of public spaces on the Central Waterfront; confirming an overall funding plan for the Central Waterfront improvements; outlining the process for formation of a Local Improvement District and completion of a fundraising plan for philanthropy; and identifying a framework for a partnership with the non profit Friends of Waterfront Seattle to operate and manage public spaces on the Central Waterfront.
