Budget Action description:

This green sheet would add \$192,000 GSF in 2018 for the Office of Economic Development (OED) to provide funding for more frequent garbage pickup and street cleaning in the Chinatown-International District (CID), specifically in alleys where dumpsters and grease containers are located.

In 2017 the Council provided the same level of funding; \$72,000 to purchase cleaning services west of I-5 and \$120,000 to provide two extra days of cleaning east of I-5, plus pressure washing one block face a week for one year. This proposal would add the same level of funding to extend those services through 2018.
