Background: LFO Inventory

- Council Resolution 31637 asked to "inventory and assess all criminal and infraction fees and fines from Municipal Court" and assess their impact on defendant reentry
- SOCR presented scope of work document to Court in mid-2016. Mutually decided Court's planning and evaluation group would draft initial study for inventory portion of work.



Scope of Initial SMC LFO Report

SOCR scope of work drove structure of the report :

Section 2: Criminal LFO Inventory	Catalog all LFOs imposed by as many available variables as possible*
Section 3: Infraction LFO Inventory	Catalog all LFOs imposed by as many available variables as possible*
Section 4: Court Priorities	Discuss policy priorities when it comes to LFO imposition

LFOs by Charge Type and Race








Figure 93: Dismissal Rate of Traffic/Non-Traffic Cases with Number of Contested Hearing/Pre-Hearing Settlement Held from 2014-2016 at SMC, by Race

Revenue by Violation Type on LFOs Collected at SMC in 2016




Figure 6: Revenue by Violation Type on LFOs Collected at SMC in 2016



Data Summary

- Parking and traffic camera money collected far exceed traffic or criminal related LFOs.
- SMC has to comply with many statutorily obligated criminal LFOs. Discretionary criminal LFOs imposed annually account for ~\$350k.
- Biggest determinant of criminal LFOs is type of charge. Demographic disparities not apparent.
- Disparities in traffic ticket amounts do exist.
