Section 1. Payment of the sum of \$21,084,190.40 on Summit mechanical warrants numbered 4002888000 - 4002890817 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E-Payables of \$178,704.44 on Summit 9000029695 – 9000029760 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of \$56,475,259.44 are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter RCW 42.24.180.

Section 2.
