Retired now, Sally Kinney spent the last dozen years of her employed life as a paralegal in Seattle law offices. As a single mother raising two children, one of them developmentally disabled, she helped organize the first national organization for parents of autistic children, and assisted in communications work for that organization in California and Washington, helping to bring autism to the attention of the public. She compiled informational newsletters and other materials for a number of her workplaces and wrote for the longest-running alternative newspaper in the country, The Northwest Passage. During the past decade, Sally served as co-chair of the Interfaith Task Force on Homelessness, involving communications with neighborhood organizations and individuals and with City officials, and composed materials to inform the large community about the problem of homelessness. She was a Board member for 3 years with the Seattle-King County Coalition on Homelessness, and now participates in three neighborhood task forces, serving as advocacy specialist for the Lake City Taskforce on Homelessness.									
For her congregation's Homeless-to-Renter move-in program, Sally writes informational and fundraising materials, and through her contacts with the community has arranged for expert speakers over the 11 years of that program's existence. She is a member of WHEEL's Women in Black and communicates that group's message of the needs of homeless people to her congregation, the organizations of which she's a member, to elected officials and those running for office, and through social media. She believes that engagement and communication with all sectors of the community is how problems get solved.
