

CM HERBOLD CB 119196 AMENDMENT 4B

This amendment is a companion to Amendment 4A of Res 31798, and increases appropriations to HSD for hygiene services while decreasing Finance General (Bridge Housing Investment Strategy) by the same amount (\$800,000)
