He also advocates for youth and young adult people living with HIV as a Pedro Zamora Young Leaders Scholar at the National AIDS Memorial Grove. He is a Washingtonian, who was born and raised in Moses Lake and enjoys track and field, tennis, and sailing the waters of the Puget Sound.
