



Dear DEP REAL ESTATE X LLC:

The purpose of this Notice is to inform you that the City of Seattle City Council is expected to vote on an ordinance authorizing the acquisition of your real property located at 3656 34th Avenue South in the City of Seattle, Washington. A copy of the proposed ordinance and a map depicting the project location are enclosed for your information. This ordinance, if adopted, will contain authorization for the City to acquire your property through negotiation, or if necessary, condemnation.

You are identified in the tax rolls of King County as the owner of the property that would be affected by this legislation. The City is required by RCW 8.25.290 to provide each property owner affected by the ordinance with formal written notice before the City takes final action authorizing condemnation of property. The time, date, and place of the final action to approve the ordinance are described below.

The City took public comment and considered the ordinance, Council Bill 119185, at the Seattle City Council Civic Development, Public Assets & Native Communities Committee as a regular part of the committee meeting on Wednesday, February 7, 2018.

The Civic Development, Public Assets & Native Communities Committee recommended approval and forwarded Council Bill 119185 on to the full City Council. The ordinance authorizing condemnation of your property will be presented for final action (adoption) to the Seattle City Council on Monday March 5, 2018 at 2:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, located at 600 4th Avenue, 2nd Floor, Seattle, WA 98104. After approval of the ordinance the City of Seattle will be authorized to acquire your property through voluntary negotiation or it may use its powers of eminent domain to condemn your property.

- AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Parks and Recreation; authorizing the acquisition of real property commonly known as 3656 34th Avenue South; authorizing acceptance and recording of the deed for open space, park, and recreation purposes; authorizing acquisition by condemnation; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.
- WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance 124468 in 2014, authorizing an interlocal agreement between The City of Seattle and the Seattle Park District ("Interlocal Agreement"), which included the Seattle Park District Financial Plan: 2015-2020; and
- WHEREAS, the Seattle Park District Financial Plan: 2015-2020 includes the Park Land Acquisition and Leverage Fund, which is to be used to acquire park lands; and
- WHEREAS, The City of Seattle, acting under the authorization of Ordinances 123709 and 124868, acquired and assembled approximately 0.75 acres in 2011 and 2016 for the development of a future park; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation has determined the acquisition of the subject real property will improve its as-yet undeveloped park, located adjacent to the subject real property; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Acquisition of the following described real property for open space, park, and recreation purposes is for a public use, and public interest, convenience and necessity require that the following described real property, situated in the City of Seattle, County of King, State of Washington, and commonly known as the property at 3656 34th Avenue South ("Property"), together with all rights, privileges, and other property

pertaining thereto, be acquired for open space, park, and recreation purposes:

LOTS 11 AND 12, BLOCK 44, C.D. HILLMAN'S RAINIER BOULEVARD GARDEN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF SEATTLE, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED IN VOLUME 12 OF PLATS, PAGE 65, IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON.

Section 2. The Superintendent of Parks and Recreation, or the Superintendent's designee, is authorized, on behalf of The City of Seattle, to negotiate and enter into an agreement to acquire the Property for a purchase price equivalent to just compensation, and to accept a deed for the Property by attaching to the deed the Superintendent's written acceptance thereof, and recording the same. The Property shall be accepted for open space, park, and recreation purposes, and placed under the jurisdiction of the Department of Parks and Recreation. The Superintendent of Parks and Recreation, or the Superintendent's designee, is also authorized to make minor amendments to the above legal description as may be necessary to correct scrivener's errors or to conform the legal description to the precise boundaries of the property required for the project.

Section 3. The Seattle City Attorney, or the City Attorney's designee, on behalf of The City of Seattle, is authorized to commence and prosecute proceedings in the manner provided by law to condemn, take, damage, and appropriate the Property in fee simple, after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owners thereof, in the manner provided by law; and to stipulate for the purposes of minimizing damages.

Section 4. The entire cost of the acquisition provided for above shall be paid from the Park Land Acquisition and Leverage Fund, or from such general fund of The City of Seattle as may be provided by law.


Section 5. Any acts consistent with the authority of this ordinance taken after its passage and prior to its effective date are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
