Later she became a member of the Food Access Team, fighting to help create access for 122,000 families in King County to receive healthy affordable food by closing the food security gap with the passage of the Sugary Beverage Tax.  Yolanda was asked to join the Got Green Board in 2015 and is dedicated to her role in lifting the voices of low income folks and people of color in her community.
