1. BILL SUMMARY

- 1. **Legislation Title:** AN ORDINANCE granting Acorn Development LLC permission to construct, maintain, and operate below-grade utility lines for a site-specific heat conveyance system and other related utilities under and across Blanchard Street between 6th Avenue and 7th Avenue, Blanchard Street between 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue, and 7th Avenue between Bell Street and Blanchard Street; specifying the conditions under which this permit is granted and providing for the acceptance of the permit and conditions.
- 2. Summary and background of the Legislation: The legislation allows Acorn Development LLC permission to construct, maintain, and operate below-grade utility lines for a site-specific heat conveyance system and other utilities under and across Blanchard Street between 6th Avenue and 7th Avenue, Blanchard Street between 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue, and 7th Avenue between Bell Street and Blanchard Street. An area map is attached for reference.

The below-grade utility lines permit is for ten years commencing on the effective date of the ordinance, with two renewable ten-year terms. The legislation specifies the conditions under which authorization is granted and provides for acceptance of the permit and conditions.

Acorn Development LLC is to pay the City of Seattle an annual fee of \$18,360 commencing on the effective date of the ordinance, and annually thereafter. Adjustments to the annual fee may be made every year and if so made shall be calculated in accordance with a term permit fee schedule adopted by City Council Ordinance 123485. An Annual Fee Assessment Summary is attached for reference.
