


Proposal

Acorn Development LLC is seeking a new permit for three utility lines for a heat conveyance system under Blanchard St between 6th Ave and 7th Ave, Blanchard St between 7th Ave and 8th Ave, and 7th Ave between Bell St and Blanchard St

- Second phase of utility lines for the below-grade heat conveyance system in Denny Triangle
 - First phase approved by Council Ordinance 124726
- These utility lines will:
 - Capture heat generated by the Westin Building data center; and
 - Recycle the recaptured heat to both heat and cool the building
- SDOT recommends approval of the ordinance

Term permit process

☑ Step 1: Resolution

Adoption of the resolution provided conceptual approval for the private use in the right-of-way, subject to the terms and conditions to be established in the term permit ordinance.

Step 2: Phase 1

Passage of the ordinance detailed the terms and conditions of the first permit, including annual fee, maintenance obligations, indemnification, insurance, and bond requirements for the first set of heat conveyance utility lines.

O Step 3: Ordinance – Phase 2

Passage of the ordinance details the terms and conditions of the second permit, including annual fee, maintenance obligations, indemnification, insurance, and bond requirements for the second set of heat conveyance utility lines.

Requested Action

- SDOT is seeking Council approval of this legislation for a new term permit to Acorn Development LLC
- If granted, this permit will be in place until 2028
