





**Type of Offense** 




### 2017 Pilot By The Numbers

 Four workshops – 88 young adults diverted on 98 fileable cases


 199 young adults on 246 police reports referred as eligible


#### POTENTIAL RECIVIDISM






### Participants by Gender & Race






# Diversion Pilot reduced racial disproportionality






# Participants reported experiencing homelessness in last 12 months
