Legislation Title: AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 125207, which adopted the 2017 Budget, including the 2017-2022 Capital Improvement Program (CIP); changing appropriations to various departments and budget control levels, and from various funds in the Budget; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts; all by a 3/4 vote of the City Council.

Summary and background of the Legislation: This legislation will implement various adjustments to the 2017 Adopted Budget that are needed to complete the City's accounting process for the year.

The proposed Bill includes discrete actions that amend the 2017 Adopted Budget by adding budget authority to various departments or transferring budget authority between BCL's to address late 2017 unanticipated charges which resulted in spending to exceed their BCL's 2017 budget authority.
