# **1. BILL SUMMARY**

**Legislation Title**: A RESOLUTION providing an honorary designation of 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue South from South Nevada Street to South Columbian Way as "Alan Sugiyama Way."

**Summary and background of the Legislation**: Seattle Department of Transportation will manufacture, install, and maintain honorary signs at the intersections of 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue South and South Nevada Street, and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue South and South Columbian Way, which shall reflect the "Alan Sugiyama Way" honorary designation. Alan Sugiyama was the founder and publisher of the Asian Family Affair newspaper, a two-term Seattle School Board member, founder and director for 30 years of the Center for Career Alternatives, and a 40-year Beacon Hill resident and advocate for correcting misrepresentation of Asian Americans in media and history textbooks.
