1. BILL SUMMARY

Legislation Title: A RESOLUTION providing an honorary designation of 15th Avenue South from South Nevada Street to South Columbian Way as “Alan Sugiyama Way.”

Summary and background of the Legislation: Seattle Department of Transportation will manufacture, install, and maintain honorary signs at the intersections of 15th Avenue South and South Nevada Street, and 15th Avenue South and South Columbian Way, which shall reflect the “Alan Sugiyama Way” honorary designation. Alan Sugiyama was the founder and publisher of the Asian Family Affair newspaper, a two-term Seattle School Board member, founder and director for 30 years of the Center for Career Alternatives, and a 40-year Beacon Hill resident and advocate for correcting misrepresentation of Asian Americans in media and history textbooks.
