1. Legislation Title:

AN ORDINANCE vacating a subterranean portion of East Howe Street between Eastlake Avenue East and Fairview Avenue East, on the petition of Bender Development, LP, and Bender Equities, Inc. (Clerk File 313430).

2. Summary and background of the Legislation:

This Council Bill completes the vacation process for a subterranean portion of East Howe Street between Eastlake Avenue East and Fairview Avenue East, in the Eastlake neighborhood, on the petition of Bender Development, LP, and Bender Equities, Inc.

The Petitioner sought the subterranean vacation for the development on two parcels on East Howe Street to share a below-grade parking structure and common utility structure, and to create a pedestrian-oriented mixed-use project with an urban plaza. Following a December 9, 2014 public hearing on the petition, the City Council conditionally granted the petition.
