1. BILL SUMMARY

- **a.** Legislation Title: AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 125493, which amended the 2018 Budget (Ordinance 125475), including the 2018-2023 Capital Improvement Program (CIP); changing appropriations to various departments and budget control levels, and from various funds in the Budget; adding new projects; revising project allocations for certain projects in the 2018-2023 CIP; creating non-exempt positions; creating a new budget summary level; amending existing CIP project descriptions; creating a new fund; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts; all by a 3/4 vote of the City Council.
- **b. Summary and background of the Legislation:** This Council Bill, which is the second quarterly supplemental ordinance in 2018, proposes several adjustments to the 2018 Adopted Budget.

The City Budget Office compiles departmental requests for spending adjustments to the Adopted Budget into a quarterly Supplemental Ordinance for review and approval by the City Council. These quarterly Bills accomplish the following:

- Implement programs approved in the Adopted Budget or subsequent legislation;
- Creates a new Budget Control Level and appropriation
- Makes changes to departments position authority
- Creates new capital improvement projects;
- Adjusts for unanticipated actual and projected revenues;
- Appropriates funding backed by new revenue sources, such as grants and private donations.

This quarterly 2nd Quarter Supplemental Ordinance is accompanied by a quarterly Grant Acceptance Ordinance.
