On-Site Childcare Study Implementation Plan
Childcare access and affordability are increasingly important issues in the City of Seattle. As the City studies evaluates how to increase the supply of childcare centers and family-child care facilities, we should take the lead on ensuring childcare access in our downtown buildings. This childcare would be open to the public in a close-to-transit downtown building. Past attempts to review this issue have stalled and this request seeks to re-open the issue highlighted challenges and next steps and . This-this report-green sheet would specifically ask the Executive to provide analysis on opening a childcare space in the vacant area near the City Grind coffee stand (first floor of City Hall) in 2019. The green sheet specifically asks the Executive to: , including:
 Identify (working with the state and external licensing experts) what, if any, structural changes would be needed to the interior and plaza exterior to meet state and local licensing requirements;

- Recruit providers to bid on the childcare facility, prioritizing providers with a proven track record of strong labor standards;
- the cost of implementing those structural changes;
- Support the development of the business model for a facility, including and regularly report back to council on any barriers or need for City subsidation anticipated costs and revenues and potentially the amount of City subsidization.
