Prior to changes to the program taking effect on April 1, 2019, the Council intends to consider further regulatory and business practice changes to the Vacant Building Monitoring Program. These include, but are not limited to: (1) promoting a caretaker model under which a vacant building could be exempt from monitoring if it is occupied by a caretaker, such as a participant from Weld Seattle, and (2) exploring ways to incentivize continued occupancy for buildings on properties planned for redevelopment.
