Budget Action description:

This green sheet caps salaries in various departments at \$150,000 per year (or \$71.84 per hour) if the salary is paid for by GF, the position is not represented by a labor organization, and the position is not for an elected official. This would require legislation to amend the pay range for various job titles with a salary range at or above \$150,000 per year (\$71.84 per hour). It is estimated that this would cut an estimated \$2,932,455 GF from the 2019 Proposed Budget and a similar amount from 2020 that could then be added to the Office of Housing for additional investments in affordable housing.

The City Council approves pay ranges and changes to pay ranges for every City job title by ordinance. If this budget action is approved, then staff will sort through the City's job titles to determine which job titles with pay above \$150,000 per year (\$71.84 per hour) are funded by GF revenues, not represented by a labor organization, and not for an elected official.

This action would require legislation which has not been introduced or referred to the Budget Committee. In order to take this action and keep the 2019 Adopted Budget balanced, the Council would need to delay action on the adopted budget by one week (to November 26, 2018).
