10	WHEREAS, the City established the City Light Rate Stabilization Account ("RSA") within the
11	Light Fund in part to buffer the City Light Department and its rate payers from shortfalls
12	in the amount of Net Wholesale Revenue actually earned relative to that specified in
13	budgets and assumed in electricity rates; and
14	WHEREAS, Ordinance 123260 provided a funding mechanism for the RSA and established
15	rules for its operation, including a formula for computing the target level of Net
16	Wholesale Revenue for the purpose of developing budgets and retail electricity rates, and
17	for determining deposits to, and withdrawals from, the RSA; and
18	WHEREAS, Ordinance 123989 changed the methodology for computing the Net Wholesale
19	Revenue target, eliminating the formula and establishing specific dollar amount targets
20	for 2013 and 2014 consistent with those assumed in the City Light 2013-2018 Strategic
21	Plan adopted by Resolution 31383; and
22	WHEREAS, the City Light 2019-2024 Strategic Plan, adopted by Resolution 31819, assumes
23	specific targets for Net Wholesale Revenue for the years 2019-2024, and electricity rates
24	consistent with those targets; and
25	WHEREAS, the City Council intends to adopt retail electricity rates for 2019 and 2020 that are
26	consistent with those in the 2019-2024 Strategic Plan; and

1	WHEREAS, Ordinance 123260 established the quarterly percentages for the distribution of net
2	wholesale revenue over the year based on the historical pattern of receipts of such
3	revenue up to that time; and
4	WHEREAS, the distribution of net wholesale revenue has changed due to changes in City
5	Light's power portfolio and wholesale energy prices, and reflection of that change would
6	allow more appropriate quarterly transfers from and to the Rate Stabilization Account;
7	and
8	WHEREAS, the City Council will reconsider spending plans, the targets for Net Wholesale
9	Revenue, and the retail electricity rates to support them for subsequent years as part of
10	the update and extension of the Strategic Plan in 2020; NOW, THEREFORE,
11	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:
12	Section 1. Subsection 21.49.086.D of the Seattle Municipal Code, which section was last
13	amended by Ordinance 125136, is amended as follows:
14	21.49.086 Rate Stabilization Account
15	* * *
16	D. Baseline for the Net Wholesale Revenue forecast:
17	((For the purpose of this Ordinance, "Net Wholesale Revenue" means gross wholesale revenue
18	less the amount of wholesale purchases.))
19	The Net Wholesale Revenue forecast shall be $((\$60))$ $\$55$ million for $((2017))$ $2019$ and
20	((\$60)) $$50$ million for $((2018))$ $2020$ .
21	The forecast ((thus established)) shall be the amount of Net Wholesale Revenue assumed
22	by the City Council for the purpose of establishing City Light rates and budgets. The City
23	Council will determine Net Wholesale Revenue forecasts for subsequent years prior to adopting
24	City Light rates for those years.

1	The annual forecast for each year will be distributed over the quarters of the year as
2	follows:
3	((30%)) 35 percent for January 1 to March 31;
4	(( <del>35%</del> )) <u>20 percent</u> for April 1 to June 30;
5	15((%)) percent for July 1 to September 30; and
6	(( <del>20%</del> )) <u>30 percent</u> for October 1 to December 31.
7	The amounts determined in this way will be the quarterly Net Wholesale Revenue
8	forecasts for the purpose of subsection 21.49.086.E and will be reported by City Light in its
9	annual budget proposals.

2	the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it
3	shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
