Historical partnerships between DEEL and SPS through the 1990, 1997, 2004, and 2011 FEL levies FEPP Levy is approved by City Council and endorsed by voters with 68% supporting

Levy Oversight Committee recommendation to transmit Partnership Agreements to Council

Mayor Durkan Executive Order to establish the Seattle Promise College Tuition Program

City, Colleges, and SPS sign a collaborative Partnership Agreement

#### **Ordinance 125604 Text**

- Section 10: The City and its partners shall develop Partnership Agreements that establish the
  roles and responsibilities of each entity in developing The Plan... in implementing EducationSupport Services, and for achieving the desired outcomes...
- Shall cover items including, but not limited to
  - data sharing necessary for student enrollment, program evaluations and course corrections,
  - standards for delivery of services,
  - curriculum alignment,
  - sharing of facilities,
  - direct contracting, and
  - other proactive methods for identifying and reaching students and schools most in need of support.
- Proceeds may only be leveraged to support Seattle School District and Seattle Colleges
  programs or functions with the existence of a current, effective Partnership Agreement.



## **Affirm FEPP Levy Investment Priorities**

#### Section 2. Partnership Statement

- Invest in Seattle children, students, families, and communities who have been historically underserved
- Assure data-driven and outcomes-based decision making
- Implement/continue evidence-based strategies and promising practices
- Provide access to capacity-building opportunities among partner organizations to improve program instruction, quality, and infrastructure
