

As stewards and regulators of land and buildings, we preserve and enhance equity, livability, safety, and health of our communities.



BACKGROUND

- Major Institutions are major employers in the City
- Seattle Pacific University (SPU) has limited area to expand
- Balance SPU growth with surrounding residential and industrial areas
- December 2018 Comprehensive Plan amendment removed three blocks from Ballard Interbay Northend Manufacturing and Industrial Center (BINMIC)



SPU AND SURROUNDING AREA






CURRENT CODE REQUIREMENTS

- Major Institution uses are allowed within 2,500 feet of existing Major Institution Overlay (MIO) boundaries
- The uses must be located within existing buildings constructed by October 7, 1987
- Major Institution Overlays cannot extend into industrial zones



AREA AFFECTED BY LEGISLATION



PROPOSED CHANGES

- Allows Major Institution Uses to expand into area north of SPU
- Allows Major Institution Overlay boundaries to expand in this limited area


