AN ORDINANCE vacating Carr Place North between North 34th Street and North 35th Street, on the petition of Seattle Public Utilities (Clerk File 312535).

Summary and background of the Legislation:

This Council Bill completes the vacation process for Carr Place North in the South Wallingford neighborhood, on the petition of Seattle Public Utilities.

The Petitioner sought the vacation for the North Transfer Station Replacement Project including a new transfer building, operations yard, administrative building, recycling area and public benefit amenities. Following an April 9, 2013 public hearing on the petition, the Council conditionally granted the petition.
