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1. BILL SUMMARY

1. Legislation Title: AN ORDINANCE approving and confirming the plat of "Seattle Modern Living on Willow" in portions of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 27, Township 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in King County, Washington.

2. Summary and background of the Legislation:

This legislation approves a 26-unit lot subdivision at 4912 S Willow St. The Hearing Examiner held a public hearing on January 26th, 2017 and issued approval of the preliminary plat of the unit lot subdivision on January 31st, 2017 subject to City Council approval.

This subdivision divides one parcel into 26-unit lots. Parcel sizes range from 1120 square feet to 2262.4 square feet. Development standards will be applied to the original parcel and not to each of the new unit lots. This subdivision is consistent with the area zoning, the Hearing Examiner recommendations, and the master use permit conditions.
