Legislation Title:

A RESOLUTION condemning the use of military force in jurisdictions such as The City of Seattle that have not requested and do not intend to request federal interventions.

Summary and background of the Legislation:

The resolution condemns the President’s statement threatening to use military force to address property damage or violence in any jurisdiction, such as The City of Seattle, that has not specifically requested such intervention.

The resolution opposes any intervention by or use of United States military forces or federalized National Guard to address property damage or other forms of violence unless such intervention is specifically requested by the Mayor of The City of Seattle together with a majority vote of the City Council.

The resolution states that the City Council does not intend to request or support intervention by United States military forces or federalized National Guard.
