**Statement of Legislative Intent:**

This Statement of Legislative Intent (SLI) requests the Seattle Police Department (SPD) to create an operational migration plan for the City's contract for Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD). SPD, in consultation with the Human Services Department (HSD), will address in the operational plan:

1. Data privacy and how SPD will protect the sensitive personal information of LEAD participants;
2. Whether and how SPD's contract management will affect its role on the LEAD Policy Coordinating Board;
3. Suggestions from HSD and members of the LEAD Policy Coordinating Board on how to improve contract management; and
4. Any plans for changes in contract management that may affect LEAD operations, such as reporting requirements or putting the contract out for bid.

The operational migration plan should be filed with the City Clerk and submitted to the Chair of the Human Services and Public Health Committee and Council Central Staff Director by May 17, 2018.
