

CB 120028 PROPOSED AMENDMENT 3

Amendment Name: SPD CopLogic Office of Inspector General Review

Sponsor: Councilmember Morales

Effects Statement: Requests the Office of Inspector General to include its 2022 annual surveillance usage review an analysis of SPD’s contractual relationship with LexisNexis and the costs and benefits of locating the CopLogic program on a city server.

Proposed Amendment:

Insert a new Section after Section 1 of Council Bill 120028 as follows and renumber sections accordingly:

Section 1. Pursuant to Ordinances 125376 and 125679, the City Council approves use of CopLogic technology and accepts the Surveillance Impact Report (SIR), for this technology, attached to this ordinance as Attachment 1 and the Executive Overview, for the same technology, attached to this ordinance as Attachment 2.

Section X. The Council requests the Office of Inspector General to include in its annual surveillance usage review for 2022 an analysis of 1) SPD’s contractual relationship with LexisNexis in support of SPD’s use of CopLogic technology, including SPD’s required records retention and sharing policies; and 2) the costs and benefits of locating the CopLogic program on a city server, utilizing the expertise of the Information Technology Department.
