11	WHEREAS, consistent with the PRA, the City identifies Public Disclosure Officers (PDOs) to		
12	respond to public disclosure requests; and		
13	WHEREAS, the role of PDO is nonpolitical and falls outside of the group of employees who		
14	transition with the electoral cycle; and		
15	WHEREAS, continuity is important to the performance of the PRA compliance function; and		
16	WHEREAS, the three departments with elected officials as the appointing authority – the Office		
17	of the Mayor, the Legislative Department, and the City Attorney's Office – have less		
18	continuity in senior management than other departments; and		
19	WHEREAS, the City strives to provide all employees with continuity in expectations and		
20	standards, and the Civil Service Commission will be able to provide the continuity to		
21	PDOs in those departments that frequently transition through elections; and		
22	WHEREAS, it is appropriate to grant civil service protections to these PDO roles; NOW,		
23	THEREFORE,		
24	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:
