AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims for the week of September 28, 2020 through October 2, 2020 and ordering the payment thereof.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Payment of the sum of \$25,155,127.44 on PeopleSoft 9.2 mechanical warrants numbered 4100378878- 4100380786 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E-Payables of \$83,844.01 on PeopleSoft 9.2 9100007409 - 9100007461 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of \$85,997,472.94 are presented for ratification by the City Council per RCW 42.24.180.

Section 2. Payment of the sum of \$50,686,685.09 on City General Salary Fund mechanical warrants numbered 51339019- 51339180 plus manual warrants, agencies warrants, and direct deposits numbered 410001 - 412687 representing Gross Payrolls for payroll ending date September 29, 2020 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council October 8, 2020 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

Section 3. Any act consistent with the authority of this ordinance taken prior to its effective date is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by

Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
