



WHEREAS, the current City inmate population at King County exceeds this limit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a 2010 Interlocal Agreement (ILA) the City began sending misdemeanor inmates to Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County terminated the ILA in 2013; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County now has space to house City misdemeanor inmates; NOW, THEREFORE;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of The City of Seattle, an agreement with Snohomish County substantially in the form attached to this ordinance as Exhibit 1, entitled “Interlocal Agreement for Jail Services Between Snohomish County and The City of Seattle.”

Section 2. Any act consistent with the authority of this ordinance taken after its passage and prior to its effective date is ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
