CITY OF SEATTLE
ORDINANCE _____

COUNCIL BILL _____

AN ORDINANCE authorizing, in 2015, acceptance of funding from non-City sources; authorizing the heads of the Human Services Department, Seattle Fire Department, Seattle Police Department and the Department of Finance and Administrative Services to accept specified grants, private funding and donations and to execute, deliver, and perform corresponding agreements; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Director of the Human Services Department, the Fire Chief, and the Chief of Police are authorized to accept the following non-City funding from the grantors listed below, and to execute, deliver, and perform on behalf of The City of Seattle, agreements for the purposes described below. The funds, when received, shall be deposited in the receiving fund identified below to support, or as reimbursement for, the corresponding appropriations set forth in the ordinance introduced as C.B. 118530.

1.2	Seattle Fire Department (SFD)	Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS)	The grant will fund replacement of much needed Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) backpack assemblies and cylinders that are at the end of their service life.	\$2,882,970	General Subfund (00100)
1.3	Seattle Fire Department (SFD)	Department of Homeland Security (DHS)	The grant will continue funding for the current Bio Watch program in the Seattle area which includes reliable air quality testing and monitoring for 16 collector sites and special events as well as strengthening the response network in Seattle to counter biological terrorism.	\$687,687	General Subfund (00100)
1.4	Seattle Fire Department (SFD)	Sound Transit	These funds will provide for the SFD personnel to complete certification and activation training and participate in rescue exercise drills for the University Link Light Rail Stations and Tunnels.	\$100,000	General Subfund (00100)
1.5	Seattle Police Department (SPD)	U.S. Department of Homeland Security	This grant provides funding to continue and enhance the City's ability to prevent, protect, respond to and recover from acts of terrorism or other emergency events.	\$114,466	General Subfund (00100)
