 AN ORDINANCE relating to City employment; authorizing the execution of collective bargaining agreements between The City of Seattle and certain unions; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.
WHEREAS, previous agreements between The City of Seattle and certain unions that established wages, hours,

benefits, and other conditions of employment have expired; and

WHEREAS, employees represented by unions continued to work after the agreements expired on condition that

the subject of their wages, hours, benefits, and other conditions of employment continue to be

negotiated; and

- WHEREAS, collective bargaining has led to agreements and/or tentative agreements between the The City of Seattle and certain unions; and
- WHEREAS, separate, future legislation will be forwarded by the City Budget Office to provide department budget appropriation authority to cover compensation authorized in the attached collective bargaining agreements;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As requested by the Seattle Human Resources Director and recommended by the Mayor, the Mayor is authorized on behalf of The City of Seattle (City) to execute a collective bargaining agreement between the City and the Washington State Council of County and City Employees Local 21PA, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, substantially in the form attached to this ordinance as Attachment 1 and identified as "Agreement by and between The City Of Seattle and The Washington State Council of County and City Employees Local 21PA, AFSCME, 21PA, AFSCME, AFL-CIO."

Section 2. As requested by the Seattle Human Resources Director and recommended by the Mayor, the Mayor is authorized on behalf of the City to execute a collective bargaining agreement between the City and the Pacific Northwest Regional Council of Carpenters, substantially in the form attached to this ordinance as Attachment 2 and identified as "Agreement by and between The City Of Seattle and The Pacific Northwest Regional Council of Carpenters," provided that union membership has ratified the agreement.

Section 3. As requested by the Seattle Human Resources Director and recommended by the Mayor, the Mayor is authorized on behalf of the City to execute a collective bargaining agreement between the City and the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, District Lodge 160, Local 79, substantially in the form attached to this ordinance as Attachment 3 and identified as "Agreement by and between The City Of Seattle and International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, District Lodge 160, Local 79."

Section 4. As requested by the Seattle Human Resources Director and recommended by the Mayor, the Mayor is authorized on behalf of the City to execute a collective bargaining agreement between the City and the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, District Lodge 160, Local 289, substantially in the form attached to this ordinance as Attachment 4 and identified as "Agreement by and between The City Of Seattle and International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, District Lodge 160, Local 289."

Section 5. Any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is ratified and confirmed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
