COUNCIL BILL	

AN ORDINANCE relating to City employment, commonly referred to as the Third Quarter 2020 Employment Ordinance; returning positions to the civil service system; and establishing a new title and corresponding rate of pay; all by a 2/3 vote of the City Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Returning eight positions from exempt to non-exempt Civil Service status</u>. As recommended by the Seattle Human Resources Director in the Classification Determination Report specified, the following positions are returned to Civil Service:
