## **CITY OF SEATTLE**

ORDINANCE

COUNCIL BILL \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE relating to City employment, commonly referred to as the Second Quarter 2022 Employment Ordinance; returning positions to the civil service system; removing positions from the Civil Service system; and amending Section 4.13.010 of the Seattle Municipal Code; all by a 2/3 vote of the City Council.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Returning seven positions from exempt to non-exempt Civil Service status</u>. As recommended

by the Seattle Human Resources Director in the Classification Determination Report specified, the following

positions are returned to Civil Service:
