 - Notable changes between the 2024 Endorsed Budget and Proposed Adjustments
 - Key drivers of expenditure and revenue changes impacting all funds and departments
- Understand the proposed adjustments to the General Fund (GF) and the impact those adjustments have on future-year deficit
- Understand the proposed adjustments to JumpStart Fund expenditures and fund policies that changed assumptions about how the fund is balanced
- Set the context for the department-specific conversations this week

Policy Considerations to Guide Discussions

- How do these adjustments impact the 6-year financial outlook for the City?
 - The GF structural deficit continues to grow in out years as costs and service needs increase.
- Without a long-term strategy on the table, how should the Council think about new ongoing spending without new ongoing resources or ongoing reductions?
 - Proposed Adjustments rely on one-time resources to fund new things, because long-term strategy is not yet determined.
 - Where there is new spending, what's the case for why it is a priority?
 - What is the process for identifying and making decisions about longer-term strategies?

There is a trade-off to every balancing strategy – the Council has the final call on how to prioritize resources amongst competing needs, in the Adopted Budget.
