Monitoring Activities



Comprehensive Assessments

To assess compliance with Consent Decree, a methodology was established and implemented to measure areas including:

- Crisis Intervention
- Stop and Detentions (including bias/disparate impact)
- Use-of-Force (including crowd management)
- Supervision

Action items in 2022:

- Finalize comprehensive assessments, integrate community feedback, and file with Court (March/April 2022)
 - There is ongoing discussion as to whether the assessments should be filed sequentially or all at once.
- Development of Monitoring Plan for 2022
- Ongoing (and carryover) monitoring activities including:
 - Accountability
 - Sentinel Event Review
 - Technical Assistance
